### ***Where is Symphony Under the Stars at Roma Street Parkland taking place ?***

Queensland Symphony Orchestra will be situated in the Amphitheatre Precinct, Roma Street Parkland.

### ***What's new at Symphony Under the Stars?***

Having achieved success for over a decade with "Symphony Under the Stars" in Gladstone, and following a few successful outdoor events in Brisbane, we have decided to give back to the community with a free classical music concert. We hope to establish a great yearly outdoor event in Brisbane! We invite you to take a look at our full program at Queensland Symphony Orchestra featuring our new Chief Conductor Umberto Clerici and hope to see you soon in the Concert Hall at QPAC or in our intimate QSO Studio, ABC Building.

### ***Do I need to book / buy a ticket and is it an all-ages event?***

This event is free to everyone, patrons are welcome to bring their children. We encourage people to register on [qso.com.au](http://qso.com.au) so we can stay in touch with you regarding the event.

### ***Will Symphony Under The Stars at Roma Street Parkland sell out?***

There should be plenty of room but to avoid disappointment come early.

### ***What time can I arrive at the site?***

The Roma Street Parkland is a free, public park in the centre of the city that is open to the public. Symphony Under the Stars event set up will be ready from 5.00pm on Saturday 25 March so feel free to come along early for a picnic and to secure your spot on the grass.

***What time does the performance commence?*** It starts at 6.30pm and finishes at 8pm.

***How long will the concert be?*** Approximately 90 minutes without interval

### ***Photography / Video***

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **What is the best way to get to Symphony Under The Stars Brisbane?**

Symphony Under The Stars is situated in The Amphitheatre, Roma Street Parkland. To access the park, enter via Foxtail or White Jacaranda Ave, opposite the Spectacle Garden.

Here are some tips for traveling to the concert:

#### Public Transport:

The Roma Street Train Station and Transit Centre are located adjacent to the Parkland (access via Platform 10). The Roma Street Busway is located inside the Brisbane Transit Centre. #### Car:

There is limited on-street metered parking within Roma Street Parkland at College Close Car Park and along Parkland Boulevard. Additionally, undercover parking is available at Cornerstone Parking, accessed via Parkland Crescent, under the Parkland Apartments residential building. Parking fees are \$4 per hour.

To navigate your way to and from the venue, Symphony Under The Stars suggests bringing a torch.

### ***Will there be any accessible access for wheelchairs or audience members with mobility issues?***

Yes, the access will be at the front of the stage.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### *Will there be food and drink available?*

There will be some food and drink options available on site. However, you are also welcome to bring your own supplies and enjoy the atmosphere with your own picnic fare.

*Is alcohol allowed?* BYO alcohol is not available in Roma Street Parkland for this event.

### *Can I bring my dog?*

We welcome dogs at the Roma Street Parkland venue, however as a responsible owner, please supervise and keep your dog under effective control using a short leash (2m or under) at all times while at Symphony Under The Stars. All dogs brought to the venue must comply with the Companion Animals Act (1998) and wear a collar displaying their name and the owner's contact information. Please clean up after your dog and dispose of their waste in the bins provided. Owners are expected to be considerate of the park and other patrons, and ensure their dogs remain quiet during the performance. Please bring water and a drinking container for your dog. Entry will be denied for aggressive dogs, and owners will be asked to leave immediately if their dog becomes disruptive or aggressive, at the discretion of Queensland Symphony Orchestra. Dogs classified as "dangerous" or "restricted," or those requiring a muzzle, will not be permitted entry to the venue.

### *What happens in case of rain or cold weather during the event?*

Please be prepared for unexpected weather conditions by packing suitable clothing to keep warm and dry, such as ponchos, blankets, and picnic rugs, especially since temperatures can drop at night in parkland venues.

### *If the event is canceled, how and when will I be informed?*

Rest assured that our Production Team closely monitors ground conditions and checks the weather forecast to make the best decision. Please note that weather conditions on-site may differ from what you are experiencing at home. While we aim to cancel as early as possible, the decision is usually not made before 4:30 pm due to unexpected weather changes. In the rare event of cancellation, we will notify you through email and update our website and social media channels. On-site signage will also be displayed. Until you receive official notification, please assume the performance will proceed as planned.
