The SidebySide Program provides important audition, learning and performance experience for aspiring musicians. It aligns with the Queensland Instrumental Music Curriculum and the Australian Curriculum by providing performance opportunities as well as technical and expressive skill development.

The concert will be held at the GPC Marina Stage on Friday 16 August 2024. Program participants will join the Orchestra for *Tales from the Vienna Woods* by Johann Strauss Jr.

Repertoire

Students are required to submit audio recordings of:

- The provided excerpt from *Tales from the Vienna Woods* by J. Strauss (listen [here](#))
- One piece of own choosing (approx. 1-1.5 minutes in duration)

Eligibility QSO can accommodate one student for each of the instruments listed below, with a maximum of ten positions available.

Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass, Flute, Oboe, Clarinet,
Bassoon, French Horn, Trumpet, Trombone, Tuba, Percussion.

Students must be currently enrolled in a Queensland Secondary school and should be of a standard equivalent to **AMEB Grade 6 and above**. Applicants will be assessed on their instrument technique and demonstrated commitment. Priority will be given to older students.
