Eligibility



Students must be **currently enrolled in a Queensland Secondary school** and should be of a standard equivalent to **AMEB Grade 6 and above**. Applicants will be assessed on their instrument technique and demonstrated commitment. Priority will be given to older students.

QSO can accommodate one student for each of the instruments listed below, with a maximum of ten positions available.

Violin 1, Violin 2, Viola, Cello, Double Bass, Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon, French Horn, Trumpet, Trombone, Percussion.

Audition requirements

String applicants Please prepare the provided excerpt (Violins choose 1st or 2nd part) AND one

Wind applicants Please prepare the provided excerpt AND one piece under 3 minutes of your

own choosing. Transposed parts available for Clarinet.

Brass applicants Please prepare the provided excerpt AND one piece under 3 minutes of your

own choosing. Transposed parts available for Trumpet and French Horn.

Percussion applicants Please prepare the provided studies for both tuned and untuned percussions.
