	Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass, Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon, French Horn, Trumpet, Trombone, Tuba, Percussion.
	Students must be currently enrolled in a Queensland Secondary school and should be of a standard equivalent to <b>AMEB Grade 6 and above</b> . Applicants will be assessed on their instrument technique and demonstrated commitment. Priority will be given to older students.

Audition Info	String applicants: Prepare the part for your instrument. Violinists prepare either 1st or 2nd violin, but not both.

	Percussion applicants: Excerpt will be provided for a snare drum. Please contact <u>edcom@qso.com.au</u> to receive music for application.
